

## THE EASTSIDE AWARD FOR COMMUNITY IMPACT

### Entry Criteria:

This award is open to organisations that can demonstrate a contribution to:

- 1) a local community or;
- 2) across a number of communities in East Belfast & Greater East Belfast areas in relation to a specific community project that demonstrates community engagement, provision of services and community impact.

Entrants are encouraged to describe the Community Project in terms of identifying the need and how they have brought the project through to completion and or sustainability.

Entrants should tell us:

- How the project was conceived, what the key features are and who is involved
- How the project is embedded within and “owned” by the community?
- What makes the project stand out?
- How the project can demonstrate impact in terms of:
  - Participation and engagement levels
  - Benefits to the community involved.
  - Follow on or sustainability of the project.
  - Contribution to the overall Community Development in East Belfast
- Any other relevant information that would support their entry.

### How to Enter:

1. Visit [www.eastsideawards.org](http://www.eastsideawards.org) and choose the category that you wish to enter/nominate in.
2. Download the category criteria and start planning how you/your organisation meets the requirements.
3. Decide whether you wish to submit a written or a video submission:

#### Video Submission:

This is a new entry mechanism for 2023 for those who would prefer to personally tell the story of them/their organisation rather than submit a written application.

**Step 1:** Fill in your details via the application form.

**Step 2:** Once you have filled in your details, you will be prompted to upload your video submission. There is no set structure for the video submission, the main aim should be to address the category criteria and tell the judges why you/your organisation deserves to win. Remember, you only have **120** seconds. Please note: It will be the strength of the entry, and how it meets the criteria, that will be assessed rather than the production of the video submission.

## Written Submission:

Written applications can either be submitted online using the online entry form or by downloading an application form from the website and emailing a completed version to [info@eastsideawards.org](mailto:info@eastsideawards.org). All written submissions must address how you/the organisation/the business or individual meet the category criteria in a maximum of **1000 words**.

## Helpful Hints:

- ✓ Take time to look at the criteria in your chosen category and use it to guide your responses.
- ✓ It is important to note that the judges will be looking for evidence that will demonstrate the contributions, achievements or impacts associated with your responses.
- ✓ Remember, the judges can only base their assessment on the information provided so please do make sure you include all relevant information to assist them in the judging process.
- ✓ Please remember that regardless of whether you submit a written or video application or nomination, the judges will assess the submission based on how the entry meets the set category criteria.

- Entries Open at **4pm Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2023**.
- Entries should be submitted or returned no later than **5pm Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2023**.
- Judging will be held at the **end of November 2023**.
- Finalists will be announced in **early December 2023**.
- The Awards ceremony will be held at Hastings Stormont Hotel on **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> Jan 2024**.
