#### Entry Criteria

This award is open to individuals involved in the promotion and provision of sports related activities that contribute to greater involvement and engagement in sporting activities in the East Belfast area.

Entrants are encouraged to provide information that demonstrates how the individual:

- Contributes to the overall SPORTS provision in East Belfast
- Engages with individuals, groups or teams from the East Belfast community and beyond
- Demonstrates high standards in what they do and personal commitment to developing their own capabilities (existing qualifications or progression to higher levels)
- Demonstrates progression in the skills levels of individuals and or teams
- Demonstrates the impact they are having in terms of
  - Numbers of participants
  - Improvements in Health & Wellbeing
- Collaborates with other SPORTS offerings if any
  - In East Belfast
  - Outside East Belfast
- Can provide examples of one or all of the following:
  - Overall aims for the sports activity in which they are involved
  - Quality of Product or Service
  - Participant feedback

#### Helpful Hints

- *Take time to look at the criteria in you chosen category and use it to guide your responses.*
- *It is important to note that the Judges will be looking for evidence that will demonstrate the contributions, achievements or impacts associated with your responses.*
- *It might be useful to create a first draft and have a colleague or a trusted friend to review your application and give you feedback.*
- *Supporting material in the form of photos, printed items, graphs – e-versions or hard copies may be brought with you on the day and left with the Judges.*
- *Remember, the judges can only base their assessment on the information provided on the entry form so please do make sure you include all relevant information to assist them in the judging process*
